

RAIN BARREL Guideline

An application is required when placing rain barrels on your property. It is recommended that the color/style of the rain barrels complement the color/style of the house (or provide adequate screening) and the number of rain barrels does not exceed the number of downspouts.

Applications should include:

- A site plan showing the proposed location of the rain barrels,
- Description of rain barrels including dimensions, color, style and materials,
- A picture or drawing of the proposed rain barrels,
- Number of rain barrels to be used,
- Description of landscape screening, if applicable,
- Description of base, if applicable.

Rain barrels should be maintained at all times and should be kept free of standing water. Overflow runoff should be properly diverted so that it does not impact neighboring properties. If rain barrels will be disconnected from downspouts during winter time, they must be stored out of sight.
